The image of a crocodile first appeared on a coin in the Roman settlement of Nemausus the area now known as Nîmes. The symbol allegorized the Roman conquest of Egypt by Emperor Augustus's legions. More than 1500 years later, the ancient emblem caught the fancy of King François I, who adapted it to the crest of Nîmes – where it remains to this day.
