### Viña Sastre Crianza 2008

In the heart of Ribera del Duero is the town of La Horra, home of Viña Sastre. This family-owned winery was founded by current owner/winemaker Jesus Sastre and his late brother Pedro. Jesus is very hands-on at the winery; by overseeing every step of the process from vine to bottle he ensures that the wine lives up to his exacting standards. He uses biodynamic and organic practices in the vineyards to ensure healthy fruit and he's always looking toward new technologies and methods to enhance the winemaking process. This combination of natural and high-tech methods produce wines that embody the spirit of Ribera del Duero. One such wine is the Viña Sastre Crianza. This wine is sourced from a combination of Viña Sastre's vineyard sites where the vines, all planted in the chalky clay that coats the region, range in age from 20 to 60 years old. The Crianza has a beautiful violet color with aromas of truffles and crushed fruit. It is very elegant on the palate with bright, sweet fruit and sweet oak notes.

Vine age: 20 to 65 years  
Soil: Clay and chalk  
Farming: Ancestral  
Vinification: Aged in new French oak for 18 months.
