In the heart of Ribera del Duero is the town of La Horra, home of Viña Sastre. This family-owned winery was founded by current owner/winemaker Jesus Sastre and his late brother Pedro. Jesus is very hands-on at the winery; by overseeing every step of the process from vine to bottle he ensures that the wine lives up to his exacting standards. He uses biodynamic and organic practices in the vineyards to ensure healthy fruit and he's always looking toward new technologies and methods to enhance the winemaking process. The newest project from Viña Sastre is their first white wine: Flavus. In collaboration with Gerardo Mendez of Do Ferreiro they decided to produce a wine with some very old plantings of Jaén that were interspersed in between old vines of Tempranillo. This wine features rich, layered mineral notes that combine with wild herbs and on the palate it has heft and density with a striking minerality.
