## Uriondo D.O. Bizkaiko Txakolina

### Uriondo Txakolina 2010

In 1987 Roberto Ibarretxe Zorriketa founded the small winery of Uriondo near Bilbao in the Bizkaiko Txakolina denomination. This small winery sits atop 2.5 hectares of vineyards at 250 meter elevation. The vineyard faces southeast and is heavily influenced by the Atlantic climate. Roberto grows the local grapes of Muni Mahatsa, Txori Mahatsa, and Hondarribi Zuri. The Muni Mahatsa and Hondarribi Zuri are fermented in stainless steel while the Txori Mahatsa is barrel fermented in American oak. The resulting wine is blended together to form Uriondo Txakolina. This wine has fresh green apples and citric notes on the nose that lead to refreshing and almost salty flavors on the palate.

Wine: Uriondo Txakolina 2010  
Grapes: 70% Mune Mahatsa and 30%  
Txori Mahatsa  
Vine age: 15-20 years  
Soil: Sand and clay.  
Farming: Non-certified organic.  
Vinification: Fermented in stainless steel.
