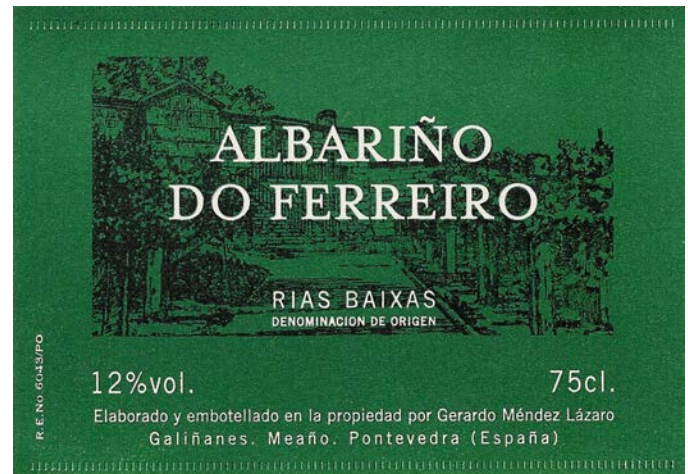


This winery, founded in 1973, is currently run by Gerardo Méndez. Gerardo owns 10 hectares, three of which are over 50 years old, and one of which is over 200 years old. The vineyards follow organic guidelines, avoiding the use of pesticides and non-organic fertilizers. In addition, Gerardo is devoted to the use of indigenous yeasts believing that through their usage the true qualities of his terruño can appear.

Gerardo farms over 175 plots of Albariño, all located in the sub-zone of Salnés. This valley's proximity to the ocean and protection by mountain ranges has gained it the reputation for being the best area in Rías Baixas for viticulture. The blend of Gerardo's plots is what makes up the Do Ferreiro Albariño.

Grapes: Albariño

Vine age: 15 - 50 years

Soil: Granite and sand

Farming: Practicing Organic

Vinification: The grapes were 100% de-stemmed and the wine was fermented with indigenous yeasts in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks.
